Streamlined Provider Credentialing with Availity Starting July 1

Beginning July 1, 2025, there will be a single process to submit applications and credentialing documents for all SoonerSelect health plans through the Availity portal. Providers will only need to submit credentialing one time through the portal. This single submission will be sufficient to cover all three health plans.

Credentialing status may be viewed via Availity. This will allow for a seamless process for business offices and will enable the health plans to leverage information already provided to support credentialing.



Caring Van expands mental health access in rural Oklahoma

GRAND Mental Health, the Oklahoma Caring Foundation, and Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Oklahoma have partnered to launch the Caring Van, a mobile unit bringing mental health services to rural and underserved communities in Oklahoma. The van, staffed by GRAND and maintained by the foundation, aims to overcome access barriers like transportation, cost, and time constraints. It will begin service soon with a flexible schedule based on community demand, potentially expanding to more vans in the future.

DeWine, mental health leaders unveil 988 license plate

On June 10, Ohio Governor Mike DeWine unveiled a new specialty license plate to raise awareness for the 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline, which provides free, confidential 24/7 support for those in behavioral health crises. Proceeds from each plate sold will fund suicide prevention programs through the Ohio Suicide Prevention Foundation. The initiative was inspired by a family who lost loved ones to suicide and led to the passage of Senate Bill 163. This effort encourages Ohioans to remember that help is always available and reaching out is a sign of strength.
